



Getting a Library Card

All lowa residents are eligible for an Alta Community Library card, and all Alta-Aurelia School students are automatically granted a library card. To sign up, fill out the application on our catalog, and then see the library. You must present proof of residence. A parent/guardian permission is required for patrons under 18. Patrons are responsible for returning their materials in a timely manner, and parent/guardain is responsible for those under 18.

Borrowing Rules

Library cardholders may check out up to 20 materials at a time, 5 of which can be movies. Check out periods are 3 weeks for books, and 1 week for movies, and materials can be renewed twice if no one else is waiting on them.. Alta-Aurelia Schools reserve the right to enforce different check out rules for student cards

Alta Community Library is proudly fine-free for books!

We do not have overdue fines for books! An overdue fine of \$1 per day will be charged to each overdue movie. Patrons are responsible for the cost of damaged or lost materials.
